## **Career Investigation Project**

## **COUN V02 - Fall 2017**

For the **Career Investigation Project**, you will need to select two professionals (not your parents/guardians and preferably not any relative) who works in a career you are interested in learning more about. You will need to ask them if you can **"job shadow" them for 2 - 8 hours** (minimum for this project is two hours per shadow experience). You will also need **15 - 20 minutes to conduct an "informational interview"** with each person so that you can ask questions about their unique career and educational journey.

The goal of this project is to see what a career of your interest looks like in the real world.

This is an excellent way to figure out if the potential career is a direction you really want to pursue, and/or this might be an opportunity to find out whether or not you want to make a long-term career commitment to a particular pathway.

You need to be ready to present your project in class (or electronically submit) on **December 13th**. Your presentation must include a visual component and be well organized with clear relevance to your career interests and exploration. You will have approximately three to five minutes to share your project outcomes including:

- Who you selected to job shadow and why
- What you learned from the shadow experience and informational interview (eg. what were your key "take aways" – summarize)
- How the experience influenced your next steps on your career and education journey this is the most important element of all©

The scoring rubric is on the opposite side of this paper and if you have any questions, please let me know. You will also need to submit the Job Shadow Verification Forms when you give your presentation.
